### OMCs: Industry volumes decline 4.7% YoY in Apr-24, 10MFY24 decline now stands at 10.9%

The OMC industry saw a 4.7% YoY decline in Apr-24, with total volumes reaching 1,104 K tons due to elevated prices and the influx of Iranian oil. This takes the overall volume decline in the first ten months of FY24 to 10.9% YoY, totaling 12,441 K tons. Motor Spirit (MS) and Furnace Oil (FO) volumes decreased by 8.6% and 58.6% YoY, respectively, while High Speed Diesel (HSD) experienced an increase of 1.9%, reflecting a shift in consumption patterns.

MS volumes declined due to a 4.3% increase in product prices during the month, while FO sales decreased because of lower demand from the power sector given higher generation cost amid subdued industrial activity. However, HSD sales experienced an uptick due to higher demand from the Agriculture and Transportation sectors.

#### PSO: Volumes decline 3.0% YoY in Apr-24, taking 10MFY24 volume decline to 11.7%

Pakistan State Oil (PSO) recorded a volume of 559 K tons in Apr-24, showing a 3.0% decrease YoY and faced 11.7% decline over 10MFY24, with total volumes at 6,230 K tons. Volumes declined across the board, with decrease of 7.3% YoY, 3.9% YoY and 22.1% YoY in MS, HSD, and FO sales, respectively.

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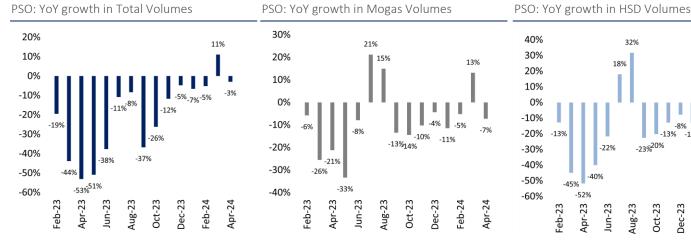
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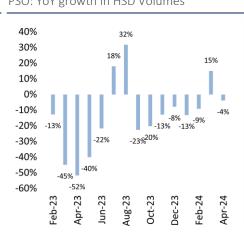

#### SHEL: Volumes fall 7.4% YoY in Apr-24, taking 10MFY24 volume decline to 15.6%

Shell Pakistan (SHEL) achieved volumes of 81 K tons in Apr-24, a 7.4% YoY decrease. Moreover, the company observed a 15.6% decrease in volume for 10MFY24, totalling 908 K tons. SHEL mirrored the industry's pattern with decline in volumes of MS during Apr-24. However, SHEL witnessed much higher decline in MS and HSD during 10MFY24.

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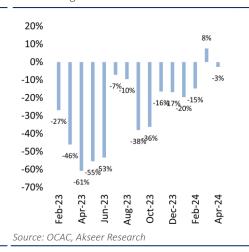




#### SHEL: YoY growth in HSD Volumes







#### APL: Volumes declined 17.6% YoY in Apr-24, taking 10MFY24 volume decline to 5.3%

Attock Petroleum Limited (APL) reported decrease in volumes by 17.6% YoY to 99 K tons in Apr-24, with a 5.3% decline in volumes for 10MFY24, reaching 1,247 K tons. Despite downturns, APL showed resilience in the MS and HSD against broader industry pressures, with MS and HSD volumes increasing by 2.2% YoY and 2.6% YoY during 10MFY24.

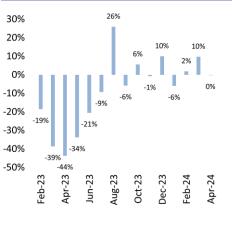
APL: YoY growth in Total Volumes

APL: YoY growth in HSD Volumes



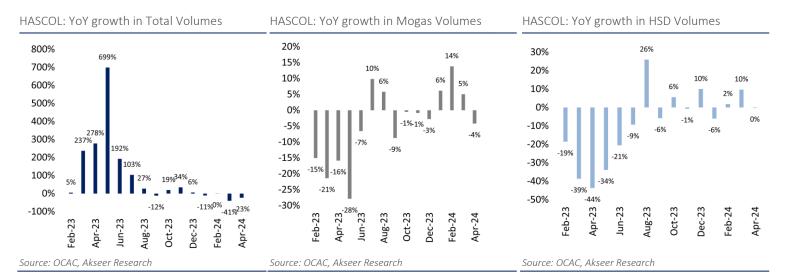
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# HASCOL: Volumes declined 23.3% YoY in Apr-24, taking 10MFY24 Volume growth to 4.8%

HASCOL faced a significant 23.3% YoY decline in Apr-24 volumes, down to 27 K tons, but saw an 4.8% increase in 10MFY24 volumes, amounting to 305 K tons.

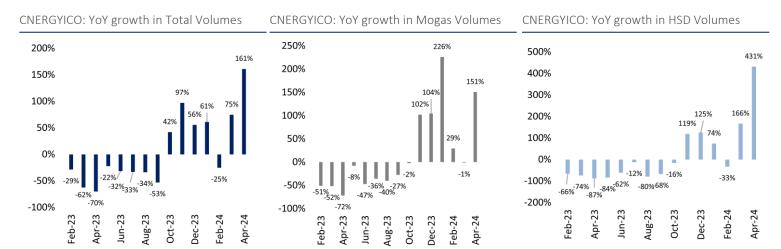


## CYNERGICO: Volumes rose 2.6x YoY in Apr-24, taking 10MFY24 volume growth to 16.5%
